NOMINATIONS FOR PARISH PASTORAL

COUNCIL Nominations are being sought for openings on
the pastoral council. There is currently 1 position available.
Council members serve a 3 year rotating term. The process of
“discernment” is used in determining the members of the
council. Please submit the name(s) of anyone, including
yourself, at least 15 years old for nomination. All nominees
will be contacted and, if interested, asked to attend the evening
of discernment which is scheduled for Wednesday June 7th at
7pm in the Parish Center. Green nomination forms are
available today in the pews and may be filled out and placed
in the box at the entrance to church. You may nominate as
many people as you wish. The parish pastoral council is a
ministry that works with the pastor in pastoral planning.
Parish pastoral matters are presented to the council, the
council's job is to investigate these matters, reflect upon and
evaluate all aspects of the matter and then formulate a
recommendation to the pastor. Meetings are held every other
month beginning September with the months of July and
August off. Meetings are currently held on the third Tuesday
of the month at 7pm for 1 hour. Please consider nominees for
