The parish pastoral council is a ministry that works with the pastor in pastoral planning. Parish pastoral matters are presented to the council, the council's job is to investigate these matters, reflect upon and evaluate all aspects of the matter and then formulate a recommendation to the pastor. Meetings are held every other month beginning September with the months of July and August off. Meetings are currently held on the third Tuesday of the month at 7pm for 1 hour.
