**New Envelope in our packets...and in your pews...for those who receive weekly envelopes, you have probably discovered a new, Reduction of Debt Envelope.** This new collection (which will eventually be scheduled for the first Sunday of each month), will help reduce our debt to the diocese for an outstanding bill for the School Assessment; complete some much needed repairs to our parish buildings (concrete repair is the first big job), and to start replenishing our depleted savings. 10 years ago, when we first started planning for our new church, we had a healthy savings account, and then we had the sale of the Chapel of Assumption, but before we could get approval for our diocesan loan, we needed to spend our savings as part of the building loan. In hindsight, this was probably not a good financial move, but at the time, it seemed most logical and most practical. We now need to 'build up' our savings and get our parish back to a healthier financial state. We have reduced our expenses, saving where we can, we have terrific fund raising efforts, but we need your help to get our parish back on track for a healthy and viable financial future. **Your support and generosity will help us achieve this goal. Thank you! If you did not receive an envelope in the mail, there are some in each pew.**

**Coupon update...** As a small group ministry, we are still busy collecting and sending manufacturers coupons to Military Families who are based overseas at several of the Army, Air Force, Navy and Marine facilities located around the world. To date since our program's inception at Sacred Heart in Lake George we have mailed 92 large flat rate boxes of coupons weighing an average of well over 16lbs. per box. **Approximately 1500 pounds of coupons in all!!!** Almost all overseas bases where the families of military personnel are housed have a Family Services Unit and/or Commissary of one type or another where the coupons are received and distributed. Manufacturer coupons can be used at these bases for up to 6 months beyond their expiration date! **NO CLIPPING** is necessary and indeed most bases seem to prefer that we send them the more or less intact coupon packet, insert or brochure. It makes distribution to the base personnel easier on their end. **Thank You to the Knights of Columbus Council 11428 for covering the mailing costs. Please keep up the great work!**
